ACADEMIC YEAR

- Year 1:** 31 study weeks including a one week induction
- Year 2:** 30 study weeks
- Year 3:** 30 study weeks

Each year is made up of two semesters consisting of 12 teaching weeks, one week consolidation/revision and two weeks to complete assessments.

The course starts with a one week induction – registration and Freshers’ Week. This week will cover study skills, how you learn on the course and an introduction to employability and legal skills. To get to know your tutors and fellow students, you can also take part in a range of social events and activities.

TYPICAL LLB CLASS SIZE

- Workshops:** 20 students
- Large groups:** 60-180 students

ASSESSMENT

Throughout the course you are assessed by a variety of different methods to enable you to demonstrate the development of your knowledge and skills. The methods of assessment include: examinations, portfolio and coursework e.g. project report or presentation.

MODULES

In each year you will study three modules per semester. You will have 12 set modules as part of your course and will be required to select six of these from the list below. At our London Bloomsbury centre, with the De Broc School of Business, you may also be able to choose business options.

Each single taught module consists of face-to-face tuition in 11 large groups and 11 x two-hour face-to-face sessions in workshops.
